



Wilderness Park

These park sites, developed in cooperation with the Southwest Florida Water Management District, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and the City of Tampa, provide access to 17,000 acres. Activities include canoeing, fishing, off-road bike trails, on-road cycling, skating, picnicking, boardwalks, and nature trails. The sites include Dead River, Flatwoods, John B. Sargeant Sr, Morris Bridge, and Trout Creek parks. Not all parks have all of the activities listed above, but provide access to the Hillsborough River and the recreational activities that remind residents of "Old Florida" scenery.
